IT'S THAT TIME OF THE YEAR AGAIN!

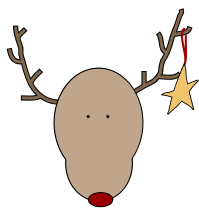

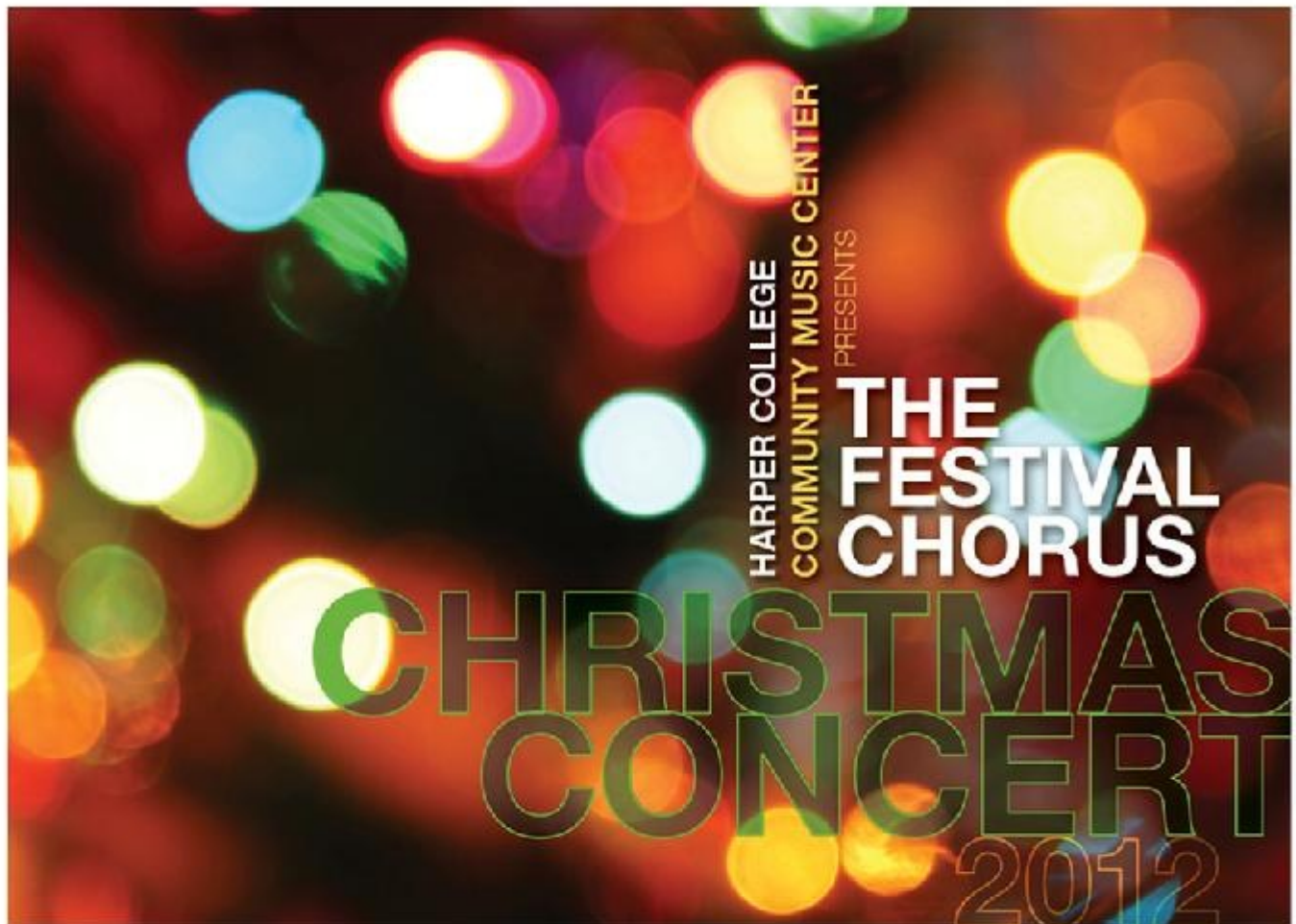
