BIOCULTURAL PERSPECTIVES ON AGING: LESSONS

FROM JAPAN - ZOOM

This course is being presented by guest professor, Melissa Melby (daughter of ICL members, Chris and Carol Melby). It explores aging by posing questions such as: Why do we age? Why does menopause exist? How does aging (and menopause) occur? What is the variation (both individual and population) in the experience of aging, and what factors influence that? We focus on Japan, a country with among the longest life expectancy in the world, and on menopause as a key turning point in the experience of aging and health. All classes will be half lecture and half interactive discussions. We will explore various perspectives and insights into many factors influencing cross-cultural variation in the experience of aging. We will discuss different levels of explanation (how vs why) and biocultural understandings of aging, and extend these ideas and approaches to other health-related phenomena such as chronic disease, and mental health.
